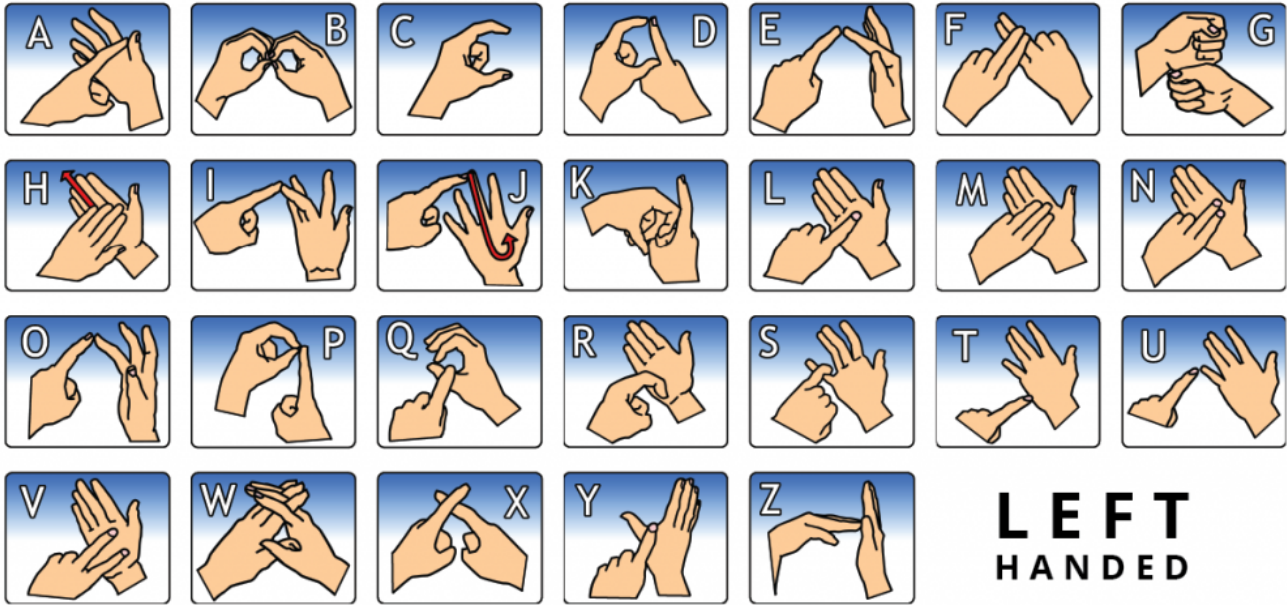
Please be reminded you must ring in each day of your child's absence from school. You can do this by either ringing the school office on 01709 543194 or leaving a message on the absence line.

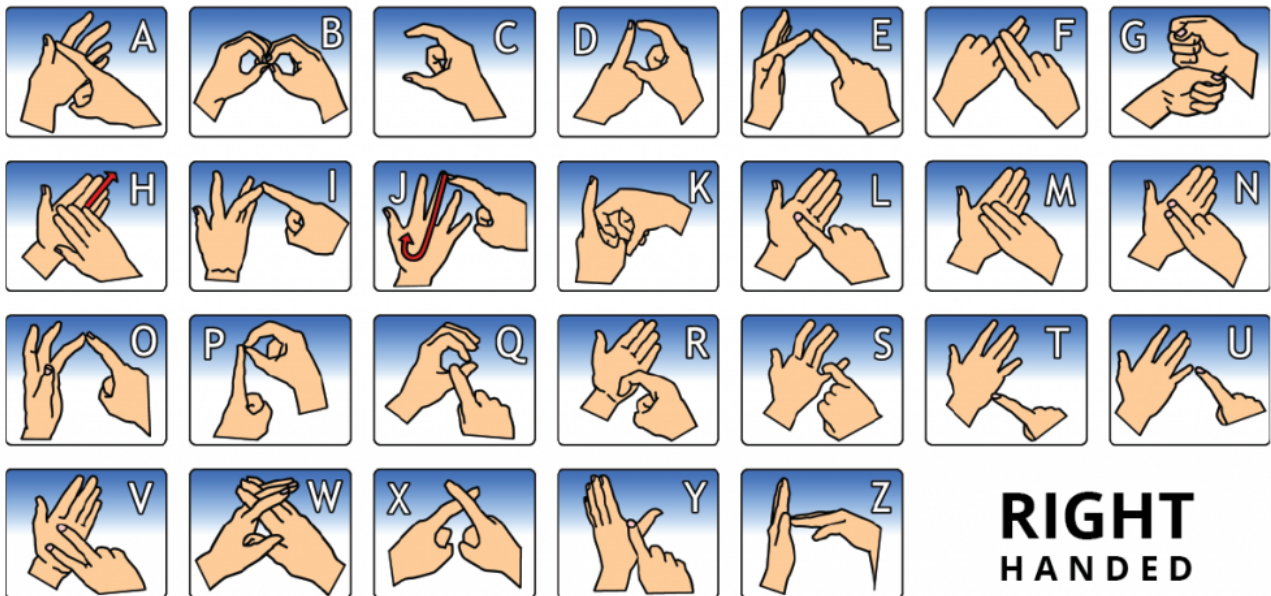

Make sure you know how to use all of my equipment, and don't shout into radio aids!



Please don't stand in front of a window when talking to me, I can't see your face. Talk normally and clearly. Shouting makes you look angry and I can't understand you.

Pictures and objects can help me understand new things and hard words.



I need to see you clearly when you talk so please don't cover your mouth.



I like it when you look at me when you're talking.



Why not learn sign and talk to more children?



I like it when you wave to get my attention.

Every deaf person is different. Some may sign, some may lipread, some may listen and some may speak. Some may do all of these things. Get deaf aware!
