Can you follow an instruction that has 2 parts? e.g. put on your coat

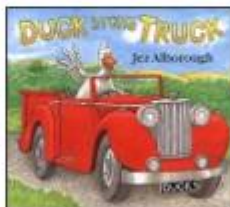
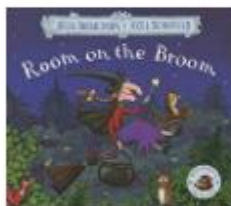


Can you write the first letter of your name?
