## Wrens Reading Prize - Spring

Dear Parents and carers,

As you are aware, reading is a huge focus of our school and we encourage all of our children to read at home at least four times per week. Each week the percentage of children reading at home is recorded and children are eligible for class and individual awards if they read four times or more at home. In the Autumn term, the Wrens had an average reading percentage of 96% which is a fantastic achievement, coming in first place out of the school for the highest percentage of reads. This is now twice in a row! The class had a vote on what they would like as their prize and unanimously decided that they would like a repeat of coming to school in their Pyjamas or comfy clothes and bring a teddy in preparation for watching a film in the afternoon.

**The film afternoon will take place on Thursday 30th March 2023.**

We would recommend that if Pyjamas are chosen over comfy clothes, please ensure the child will be warm enough when playing outside, not too warm when in school and also are able to get in and out of the garments without assistance e.g. from a onesie. If a onesie is the clothing item of choice, please ensure there are clothes underneath in case the child gets too warm.

With regards to bringing a teddy or cuddly toy, please be advised the teddy must be no bigger than something that can sit on the child's desk and is the responsibility of the child to look after during the day.

The children will decide together which film they would like to watch. The children may choose a PG rated film so if you would prefer your child **not** to watch a PG film, please contact school.
